

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the House of Representatives in honor and loving
2 memory of Jack Harry Horn.

3 WHEREAS, Jack Harry Horn was born in Inez, Martin County, Kentucky, on
4 December 8, 1944; and

5 WHEREAS, Jack Horn graduated from Inez High School in 1963, Berea College in
6 1967, and then the University of Kentucky School of Law in 1970 before enlisting in the
7 United States Army; and

8 WHEREAS, while serving, Jack was stationed at Fort Knox, Kentucky and Fort
9 Polk, Louisiana, became an awarded Drill Sergeant, and was honorably discharged in
10 1974; and

11 WHEREAS, Jack Horn returned to Inez to open his law practice, where he stayed
12 for over 46 years. He assisted his community as Trial Commissioner, Domestic Relations
13 Commissioner, and Assistant County Attorney. Then he was elected as Circuit Court
14 Clerk of Martin County until his retirement in 2016; and

15 WHEREAS, Jack Horn was an active member of Marion Hale Masonic Lodge #672
16 in 1971. He represented the lodge as the Pass Master. He was District Deputy Grand
17 Master of Murfield Lodge #882 and a member of the Ted Adams Lodge of Research,
18 #998. He also was a Shriner at El Hasha Shriners in Ashland, Kentucky; and

19 WHEREAS, Jack Horn departed this earthly life on March 18, 2018, leaving his
20 family, his friends, and his community missing his upbeat manner and smile; and

21 WHEREAS, Jack Horn is survived by his high school sweetheart and wife of 49
22 years, Gladys Copley Horn; his beloved children, Jackie Leigh Horn, Esq. and Dr. Todd
23 Lindsey Horn; and his five wonderful grandchildren, Andrew William Holt, Allison
24 Leigh Holt, Ashton Blake Holt, Jackson Chase Horn, and Lindsey Caroline Horn;
