A RESOLUTION honoring Representative Jody Richards upon his retirement from
 the House of Representatives.

WHEREAS, Representative Jody Richards was born on February 20, 1938. A
graduate of Kentucky Wesleyan College and the University of Missouri, he is a veteran of
the United States Army Reserve; and

6 WHEREAS, Representative Richards was a professor at Western Kentucky 7 University when he was elected for his first term in the Kentucky House of 8 Representatives in 1975. During his more than four decades of service to this body, he 9 has worked diligently to honor the best interests of his district and to improve the quality 10 of life of all Kentuckians; and

WHEREAS, in 1987 Representative Richards was chosen by Democratic leadership to serve as Majority Caucus Chairman, and in 1995 he was elected as Speaker of the House. The longest-serving Speaker in Kentucky history, he proudly led the House for 14 years. He has served on the Appropriations and Revenue Committee, the Education Committee, and the State Government Committee, as well as on a number of interim committees; and

WHEREAS, Representative Richards is a staple of the Bowling Green community.
The former owner of Superior Books, he is a longtime member of the Greenwood Park
Church of Christ and the Bowling Green/Warren County Jaycees, which he served as
president; and

WHEREAS, Representative Jody Richards is rightfully honored on this day for his service to this Commonwealth as a member of the Kentucky House of Representatives. His tireless work on behalf of his constituents, particularly his tenure of Speaker of the House, is justly acknowledged by the members of this body, and for his 42 years of service as a legislator, for the countless hours he spent working on behalf of his district, and for his achievements as a human being of the first order, he is hereby commended and granted best wishes as he begins a new chapter of his life;
