1	A RESOLUTION adjourning the House of Representatives in honor and loving
2	memory of Dr. Pearse Lyons.
3	WHEREAS, "If you can't sell Kentucky as a place to do business, then you're not in
4	any shape or form a salesman, because it's an easy sell."—Pearse Lyons
5	WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Kentucky has lost one of its most treasured
6	sons. Dr. Pearse Lyons, businessman, philanthropist, and innovator, has passed at the age
7	of 73; and
8	WHEREAS, Pearse Lyons was born on August 3, 1944, to the late Thomas Kevin
9	and Margaret Lyons in Dundalk, Ireland. He was one of six children; and
10	WHEREAS, Pearse Lyons' mother owned a small grocery shop, which he later
11	acknowledged as the inspiration behind his entrepreneurial drive. His first job was at the
12	age of 14 at Harp Lager in Dundalk, where he helped in the laboratory; and
13	WHEREAS, on his mother's side, Pearse Lyons came from five generations of
14	coopers who supplied barrels to distilleries in Ireland; and
15	WHEREAS, Pearse Lyons was educated at University College Dublin, where he
16	graduated with first-class honors. He went on to study at the British School of Malting
17	and Brewing in Birmingham, where he earned master's and doctoral degrees, and was the
18	first Irishman to receive a formal degree in brewing and distilling from the university; and
19	WHEREAS, Pearse Lyons interned at the Guinness and Harp Lager Breweries and
20	worked as a biochemist for Irish Distillers, the makers of Jameson Whiskey. He was
21	instrumental in designing the Midleton Distillery for Jameson, an opportunity which he
22	considered to be a highlight of his early career; and
23	WHEREAS, Pearse Lyons married his cherished wife, Deirdre, in 1972. Their
24	daughter, Aoife Louise, was born in 1973, and their son, Mark, was born in 1976. Both
25	his children are now full-grown and are leaders in the family business. Dr. Aoife Lyons is
26	a licensed clinical psychologist and global director of educational initiatives for the
27	company, while Dr. Mark Lyons is the president and chairman. Deirdre, the co-founder of

1 Alltech, is director of corporate image and design. She designs and outfits the company's 2 more than 80 offices around the world, and oversees Alltech's philanthropic involvement; 3 and 4 WHEREAS, Pearse Lyons moved to the United States in 1976, having been asked 5 by Irish distillery Gems Whisky to help ethanol distilleries in Kentucky improve their 6 processes; and 7 WHEREAS, in 1980, Pearse Lyons launched his own business. Alltech was begun 8 in his garage on an initial investment of \$10,000, with just enough money left over to pay 9 for groceries and mortgage. In its first year of operation, Alltech earned over a million dollars; and 10 11 WHEREAS, Alltech's name is based on the initials of Pearse and Deirdre's 12 daughter, Aoife Louise Lyons. The company's logo color was their son's Mark's choice; 13 and 14 WHEREAS, Alltech would become the fastest-growing company in the global 15 animal health and nutrition industry; and 16 WHEREAS, Alltech has a global team of more than 5,000 people, and the 17 company's mission has always been guided by Pearse Lyons' early commitment to the 18 "ACE principle," which is the promise that the company's work must have a positive 19 impact on the Animal, the Consumer, and the Environment; and 20 WHEREAS, Pearse Lyons used his monumental success at Alltech to begin other 21 initiatives that would profoundly impact the Commonwealth. In 1980, he established The 22 Alcohol School in Lexington, which he ran for 25 years. He also co-authored *The Alcohol* 

The first beer from Dr. Lyons' new brewery, Alltech Lexington Brewing and Distilling Company, was Kentucky Ale, a blend of two classic beer styles—an Irish red ale and an Page 2 of 6

WHEREAS, in 1999, Pearse Lyons purchased the Lexington Brewing Company.

Textbook, which became a key source for the beverage, fuel, and industrial alcohol

industries; and

1 English pale ale. Another breakthrough came several years later when Kentucky Ale was 2 placed into freshly emptied bourbon barrels from nearby distilleries to soak up the fresh 3 bourbon and oak flavors. This brew was known as Kentucky Bourbon Barrel Ale and 4 soon became the brewery's flagship brew after its introduction to the market in 2006. It is 5 regarded as one of the forerunners of the bourbon-barrel aging trend in craft beer; and 6 WHEREAS, in 2008, using two copper pot stills brought in from Scotland, the 7 company distilled its first batches of whiskey in the brewery, and the company name was 8 changed to Alltech Lexington Brewing and Distilling Company. This new distillery was 9 added to the Kentucky Bourbon Trail and was the first craft distillery to be inducted into 10 the Kentucky Distillers' Association. Town Brand Distillery now produces a line of 11 spirits, including Pearse Lyons Reserve, a male whiskey introduced to the world on Dr. 12 Lyons' birthday, fulfilling his dream of one day having his own whiskey; and 13 WHEREAS, Pearse Lyons continued to build upon his brewing and distilling 14 passion—and his legacy—when in 2017 he and Deirdre realized their dream of opening 15 an Irish whiskey distillery in Dublin. Their quest was to find the perfect location led them 16 to the long-abandoned St. James Church in The Liberties district of the city. The church 17 had been built prior to the Magna Carta, and Dr. Lyons and Deirdre set about 18 painstakingly restoring it. The design project was led by Deirdre, introducing iconic new 19 elements, such as a landmark glass spire—dubbed the "Liberties Lantern"—and stained 20 glass windows designed by Deirdre herself. The creation of the new Pearse Lyons 21 Distillery at St. James was made much more meaningful by the fact that Dr. Lyons' great-22 grandfather and several other relatives were buried in the churchyard; and 23 WHEREAS, for his contributions to science and industry, Pearse Lyons was named 24 Business Person of the Year by Business and Finance Magazine. He also received the 25 prestigious Ireland-U.S. Council Award for Outstanding Achievement, and Irish Prime 26 Minister Enda Kenny recognized him with the St. Patrick's Day Science Medal in 27 recognition of creating a global business based on scientific research. He also received the

1 Henry Clay Medallion for Distinguished Service, past recipients of which include Sandra 2 Day O'Connor, Ted Turner, and Princess Haya Bint Al Hussein; and he was selected to 3 receive the Commander's Award for Public Service; and 4 WHEREAS, Dr. Lyons spearheaded Alltech's commitment to international 5 equestrian sport by sponsoring the Alltech FEI World Equestrian Games in 2010 in 6 Lexington, which led to his receipt of the Commonwealth's first-ever Legacy Award in 7 2011; and 8 WHEREAS, Pearse and Deirdre Lyons share a deep passion for education. They 9 oversaw the construction of more than a dozen state-of-the-art science laboratories at 10 primary schools in Kentucky and Ireland; these labs were completed as a tribute to Dr. Lyons' late brother, Father Kevin Lyons, a priest who had tirelessly worked to improve 11 12 the lives of children. Many of the schools with new labs went on to achieve coveted Blue 13 Ribbon Schools of Excellence status; and 14 WHEREAS, Pearse Lyons also spent much of his professional life encouraging 15 aspiring scientists and entrepreneurs. The Alltech Young Scientist Program, the largest 16 global agriscience competition of its kind, has engaged more than 100,000 university 17 students. More than 450 undergraduates have completed an internship at the Alltech 18 Center for Animal Nutrigenomics and Applied Animal Nutrition in Kentucky, and nearly 19 440 graduate students are being supported through Alltech's bioscience centers. Also at 20 the university level, Dr. Lyons initiated an Alltech Innovation Competition, which 21 awarded entrepreneurs with \$10,000, the same amount with which he founded Alltech; 22 and 23 WHEREAS, Pearse Lyons was a passionate philanthropist whose giving had 24 touched the lives of so many people in this Commonwealth and across the world. He 25 proudly established Alltech's ACE Involvement Foundation, a charitable initiative to help 26 fund the company's philanthropic efforts. Eager to do something to support Haiti 27 following the 2010 earthquake, Dr. Lyons determined he would create a sustainable

1 Haitian enterprise that could provide a "hand up" to the country's residents. He found a

- 2 gem in the country's 100 percent mountain-grown, organic Arabica coffee. These efforts
- 3 include Alltech Cafe Citadelle, a Haitian coffee that offers "a cup of hope," the profits of
- 4 which are reinvested into two primary schools in northern Haiti; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Pearse Lyons was particularly well-known for leading Alltech's
- 6 international conference, branded in recent years as ONE: The Alltech Ideas Conference.
- 7 Held for more than three decades, the event has become Lexington's largest annual room
- 8 booking, attracting nearly 4,000 people from more than 70 countries; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Pearse Lyons lived his life with passion, energy, and a boundless sense
- of purpose; and
- WHEREAS, it is appropriate that this body pause on this day to reflect on Pearse
- 12 Lyons' many accomplishments, and to duly thank him, his wife Deirdre, and all those at
- Alltech who will oversee the enduring vision Dr. Lyons began in that garage almost four
- 14 decades ago; and
- WHEREAS, on March 8, 2018, Pearse Lyons departed this earthly life, leaving
- 16 everyone whose lives he touched—in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, in his beloved
- 17 Ireland, and across the world—in solemn mourning; and
- WHEREAS, Pearse Lyons is survived by his loving wife, Deirdre; daughter, Aoife;
- son, Mark and his wife, Holly; and a host of other family members, friends, and loved
- 20 ones who will dearly miss his presence in their lives;
- 21 NOW, THEREFORE,
- 22 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the
- 23 Commonwealth of Kentucky:
- → Section 1. The members of the House of Representatives, both individually and
- collectively, hereby express their most profound sympathy upon the passing of Dr. Pearse
- 26 Lyons, and posthumously thank him for the enduring legacy he leaves behind in our
- 27 Commonwealth.
