

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the House of Representatives in honor and loving

7 in 2001; and

8 WHEREAS, since 2011, Jenniffer Michelle Craig had proudly served in the  
9 Taylorsville-Spencer County Fire Department. A certified SCUBA diver, she assisted  
10 with the dive and rescue team and was a part-time EMT for Spencer County EMS; and

11 WHEREAS, Jenniffer Michelle Craig, beloved wife and sister, departed this earthly  
12 life on December 15, 2017, leaving her family, friends, and all those whose lives she  
13 touched in solemn mourning; and

14 WHEREAS, it is appropriate that this honorable body recognize those Kentuckians  
15 who serve their communities with such courage and valor that they become examples for  
16 all those who live in our great Commonwealth; and

17 WHEREAS, in so doing, this body honors Jenniffer Michelle Craig on this day and  
18 posthumously thanks her for all she accomplished as a member of the Taylorsville-  
19 Spencer County Fire Department; and

20 WHEREAS, Jenniffer Michelle Craig is survived by her husband, Kenneth Craig;  
21 sister, Amy Trzyna; beloved dog, Maggie Rose; and a host of other family members,  
22 friends, and loved ones who will dearly miss her presence in their lives;
