

1 AN ACT proposing to amend Sections 30 and 31 of the Constitution of Kentucky
2 relating to elections of members of the General Assembly.

3 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

4 ➔Section 1. It is proposed that Section 30 of the Constitution of Kentucky be
5 amended to read as follows:

6 Members of the House of Representatives and Senators shall be elected at the
7 general election in even-numbered years for terms of ~~six~~^{four} years for Senators and
8 ~~four~~^{two} years for members of the House of Representatives. The term of office of
9 Representatives and Senators shall begin upon the first day of January of the year
10 succeeding their election.

11 ➔Section 2. It is proposed that Section 31 of the Constitution of Kentucky be
12 amended to read as follows:

13 At the general election to be held in November ~~2020~~¹⁹⁸⁴, and every ~~six~~^{two}
14 years thereafter, there shall be elected for ~~six~~^{four} years one Senator in each ~~odd-~~
15 ~~numbered~~ Senatorial District~~[in which the term of his predecessor in office will then~~
16 ~~expire and in every Representative District one Representative for two years].~~ **At the**
17 **general election to be held in November 2020, and every four years thereafter, there**
18 **shall be elected for four years one Representative in every Representative District. At**
19 **the general election to be held in November 2022, and every six years thereafter, there**
20 **shall be elected for six years one Senator in each even-numbered Senatorial District.**

21 ➔Section 3. This amendment shall be submitted to the voters of the
22 Commonwealth for their ratification or rejection at the time and in the manner provided
23 for under Sections 256 and 257 of the Constitution and under KRS 118.415. The question
24 to be presented to the voters shall read as follows: "Are you in favor of electing Senators
25 in the Kentucky Senate to terms of six years and of electing Representatives in the
26 Kentucky House of Representatives to terms of four years beginning with members
27 elected at the general election held in November 2020?"
