- 3 → Section 1. KRS 12.070 is amended to read as follows:
- For the purpose of this section, "minority" means American Indian; Alaskan native; 4
- 5 African-American; Hispanic, including persons of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban,
- 6 and Central or South American origin; Pacific islander; or other ethnic group
- 7 underrepresented on state boards and commissions.
- 8 Except as otherwise expressly provided by law, the members of each administrative (2)
- 9 board or commission shall be citizens of Kentucky appointed by the Governor from
- 10 the state at large on the basis of their interests in public affairs, their good judgment,
- and their knowledge and ability in the field of action of the department for which 11
- 12 appointed, with a view to providing diversity of interests and points of view in the
- 13 membership and without regard to their political or religious opinions or
- 14 affiliations.
- 15 (3) Where appointments to administrative boards and commissions are made from (a)
- 16 lists submitted to the Governor him, the Governor may reject the list and
- 17 require that other lists be submitted.
- (b) If, after a period of sixty (60) days, no new list has been submitted and, after 18
- 19 notification to the entity submitting the original list, the Governor may
- 20 appoint a member at his or her discretion.
- 21 Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, in the event the current (c)
- 22 membership of a board or commission reflects a proportion of the minority
- 23 group less than the proportion of the minority group in the total population of
- 24 the Commonwealth, then the Governor may appoint a member of the minority
- 25 group even if the list of nominees for a vacancy does not include a member of
- 26 the minority group.
- 27 (4) Before entering upon the duties of their office, all members of administrative boards

- 3 (5) When a board, commission, or similar administrative body is established and no
