3		<b>→</b> S	ection 1. KRS 411.245 is amended to read as follows:
4	(1)	A p	erson who enters a vehicle, as defined in KRS 503.010, for the purpose of
5		remo	oving a minor or a domestic animal shall be immune from civil liability for any
6		resu	lting damage to the vehicle if the person:
7		(a)	Has a reasonable, good faith belief, based upon the circumstances known to
8			the person at the time, that entry into the vehicle is necessary because the
9			minor or domestic animal is in imminent danger of physical injury if not
10			immediately removed from the vehicle;
11		(b)	Has contacted local law enforcement, the local fire department, or a 911
12			emergency telephone service prior to entering the vehicle;
13		(c)	Uses no more force to enter the vehicle and remove the minor or domestic
14			animal than is reasonably necessary under the circumstances; and
15		(d)	1. Remains with the minor <u>or domestic animal</u> in a safe location, out of the
16			elements but reasonably close to the vehicle, until law enforcement,
17			firefighters, or other emergency responders arrive; or
18			2. Reasonably determines that emergency conditions require leaving the
19			scene with the minor or domestic animal, and places written notice on
20			the vehicle containing:
21			a. The person's contact information;
22			b. The reason entry into the vehicle was made;
23			c. The [minor's ] location of the minor or domestic animal; and
24			d. Notice that authorities have been contacted.
25	(2)	This	section does not limit a person's immunity from civil liability or defenses
