3		➤ Section 1. KRS 218A.170 is amended to read as follows:
4	(1)	A duly licensed manufacturer, distributor, or wholesaler may sell or distribute
5		controlled substances, other than samples, to any of the following persons:
6		(a) To a manufacturer, wholesaler, or pharmacy;
7		b) To a practitioner;
8		c) To the administrator in charge of a hospital, but only for use by or in that
9		hospital;
10		d) To a person in charge of a laboratory, but only for use in that laboratory for
11		scientific and medical research purposes;
12		(e) To a person registered pursuant to the federal controlled substances laws.
13	(2)	A pharmacist may sell or distribute a controlled substance:
14		a) Pursuant to a prescription that conforms to the requirements of this chapter; or
15		(b) To a person registered pursuant to the federal controlled substances laws.
16	(3)	A pharmacist shall sell or distribute a nontoxic composition for the sequestration
17		or deactivation and disposal of unused, unwanted, or expired controlled
18		substances anytime a controlled substance is sold or distributed. The nontoxic
19		composition must permanently capture the controlled substance.
20	<u>(4)</u>	A practitioner may:
21		(a) Administer, dispense, or prescribe a controlled substance only for a legitimate
22		medical purpose and in the course of professional practice; or
23		b) Distribute a controlled substance to a person registered pursuant to the federal
24		controlled substance laws.
25	<u>(5)</u>	A practitioner shall sell or distribute a nontoxic composition for the sequestration
26		or deactivation and disposal of unused, unwanted, or expired controlled
27		substances anytime a controlled substance is dispensed or distributed. The

1	nontoxic composition must permanently capture the controlled substance.
2	(6)[(4)] All sales and distributions shall be in accordance with KRS 218A.200 and the
3	federal controlled substances laws, including the requirements governing the use of
4	order forms.
5	(7)[(5)] Possession of or control of controlled substances obtained as authorized by
6	this section shall be lawful if in the regular course of business, occupation,
7	profession, employment, or duty of the possessor.
