

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION designating a portion of Kentucky Route 39 in Jessamine
2 County in honor and memory of Nancy Stacy Breiner.

3 WHEREAS, Nancy Breiner was born March 16, 1921, the daughter of the late Guy
4 Meredith and Berta Askins Stacy; and

5 WHEREAS, Nancy Breiner, sometimes affectionately referred to as "Mayor," was a
6 lifelong resident of the community of Sulphur Well; and

7 WHEREAS, Nancy Breiner joined Sulphur Well Christian Church on Easter
8 Sunday in 1935, and continued her devotion to the church her entire life. She was a
9 member of the choir and the L.W. Society. Nancy never hesitated to lend a hand when
10 needed; and

11 WHEREAS, Nancy Breiner operated the Trading Post Grocery from 1939 to 1990
12 with her father and her husband; and

13 WHEREAS, Nancy Breiner's community involvement included being a member of
14 the Happy Chandler Happy Club and the Beef Cattlemen's Association; and

15 WHEREAS, on September 10, 2013, Nancy Breiner departed these earthly bounds.
16 She was preceded in death by her husband, Joseph Breiner. She leaves to cherish her
17 memory, sons James, Joseph, and Ronald, as well as a host of family and friends;

18 NOW, THEREFORE,

19 ***Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

20 ➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 39 in
21 Jessamine County, from its intersection with Chrisman Mill Road to its intersection with
22 Elm Fork Road, as the "Nancy Stacy Breiner Memorial Highway," and shall, within 30
23 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect the appropriate signage.
