WHEREAS, Taiwan and the United States are longstanding allies who both deeply
cherish the common values of freedom, democracy, human rights, and the rule of law;

5 WHEREAS, in the year 2016, Taiwan held its sixth direct presidential election and 6 again demonstrated the strength and vitality of its democratic system, paving the way for 7 Taiwan as a beacon of democracy in Asia and beyond. Tsai Ing-wen was elected as the 8 14th President of Taiwan, becoming the first female president in the country's history, and 9 along with her Vice President Chen Chien-jen, she hopes to continue to build the 10 country's already rich tradition of economic vitality, cultural growth, and innovation; and

WHEREAS, Taiwan serves the best interests of the Asia-Pacific region in the
continuation of stability and growth; and

WHEREAS, Taiwan and mainland China have signed more than 20 agreements in the past decade. United States businesses can collaborate with innovative Taiwanese companies in Taiwan's comprehensive protection of intellectual property rights, and then use Taiwan as a springboard for entering mainland China and other key Asian markets; and

WHEREAS, since 1982, the Commonwealth of Kentucky and Taiwan have enjoyed
long, cordial, and mutually beneficial sister-state relations, a friendship that continues to
strengthen with each passing year; and

WHEREAS, Taiwan is the United States' ninth-largest trading partner, and the
United States is Taiwan's second-largest trading partner. In 2016, Kentucky's exports to
Taiwan reached \$174.1 million; Taiwan is Kentucky's seventh largest export market in
Asia; and

WHEREAS, the designation of Taiwan into the United States' Visa Waiver Program is a significant step to draw travelers from Taiwan choosing the United States as their destination for trade, investment, and sightseeing; and
