

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Bobby
2 Brockman.

3 WHEREAS, Bobby Brockman was born in Taylor County, Kentucky on October
4 29, 1956, to the late Albert Brockman and Anna Mary Perkins Brockman; and

5 WHEREAS, Bobby Brockman attended the University of Tennessee where he
6 worked as a manager for Coach Ray Mears; and

7 WHEREAS, Bobby Brockman was the sports editor for the Central Kentucky News
8 Journal, the sports historian for Campbellsville University Athletics, and the sports
9 aficionado for both the Big Dawg and WAVE radio stations; and

10 WHEREAS, Bobby Brockman influenced his community with his enthusiasm for
11 sports by coaching some local softball leagues and was a fixture at Jeff's Food Mart
12 during lunchtime; and

13 WHEREAS, Bobby Brockman departed this earthly life on January 7, 2018, leaving
14 those who knew and loved him in solemn mourning; and

15 WHEREAS, Bobby Brockman was preceded in death by his parents; his brother,
16 Buddy Brockman; and his mother-in-law and father-in-law, Charles and Josephine Noel;

18 WHEREAS, Bobby Brockman is survived by his wife of 33 years, Sonja Noel
19 Brockman; his three daughters, Rachel Brockman, Melanie Brockman, and Savanna
20 Brockman; his one granddaughter, Eden Caroline Kent; his brother, Joe Brockman; his
21 sister, Sandra Spurling; and several nieces and nephews and many other relatives and
22 friends;
