3 WHEREAS, Kentucky is a welcoming state that celebrates the growing diversity of 4 its residents and acknowledges that refugees, immigrants, and all newcomers are vital 5 contributors to the success of our communities, local economies, and shared future; and 6 WHEREAS, refugees and immigrants come to Kentucky with the promise of 7 freedom, hope, and opportunity in a new country and enhance our communities; and 8 WHEREAS, community and faith-based organizations throughout the 9 Commonwealth continue to welcome refugees and immigrants arriving in Kentucky; and 10 WHEREAS, Kentucky is home to a diverse population of refugees and immigrants, 11 adding to the economic strength and cultural richness of our Commonwealth; and 12 WHEREAS, we believe all individuals-regardless of their national origin or 13 faith—deserve to live with dignity, fair and equal treatment, and the means to support 14 their families in safe and vibrant communities; and 15 WHEREAS, all persons, including those new to our Commonwealth, should be 16 afforded the opportunity to participate in the democratic process; 17 NOW, THEREFORE, 18 Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of 19 Kentucky: 20 \rightarrow Section 1. The Senate hereby proclaims March 7, 2018, as the fifth annual 21 Refugee and Immigrant Day at the Capitol in Kentucky in order to affirm the beauty and 22 richness of our diversity, and one in which all are welcomed, accepted, and appreciated. 23 \rightarrow Section 2.
