15	develop literacy expertise to assist all learners in the achievement of their full potential

18	development and coaching for early childhood through adulthood educators, assisting
19	districts located in areas with low reading skills, developing a CCLD clearinghouse for
20	research, collaborating with public and private postsecondary institutions, and creating a

23	educators and educational initiatives that go above and beyond to help those learners in
