

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Daniel
2 Martin "Danny" Schapmire.

3 WHEREAS, on May 3, 1944, Daniel Martin "Danny" Schapmire was born in Ohio
4 County, Kentucky, the cherished son of the late Martin Casebier Schapmire and Lucille
5 Daniel Schapmire; and

6 WHEREAS, Daniel Martin "Danny" Schapmire was a proud graduate of the
7 Kentucky School of Mortuary Science. He retired after 50 years as co-owner, funeral
8 director, and embalmer at Miller-Schapmire Funeral Home in Hartford, Kentucky. Mr.
9 Schapmire later became a certified real estate appraiser; and

10 WHEREAS, Daniel Martin "Danny" Schapmire was a devout member of the
11 Beaver Dam Baptist Church and a 50-year member of the Funeral Directors Association
12 of Kentucky. He enjoyed being with his family and friends and serving the community;

15 earthly life, leaving those whose lives he touched in solemn and resolute mourning; and

16 WHEREAS, Daniel Martin "Danny" Schapmire is survived by his wife of 50 years,
17 Suzanne Schapmire; his sons, Marty Schapmire and his wife, Tara, and Chad Schapmire
18 and his wife, Sally; his grandchildren, Lily Schapmire and Nick Schapmire; his sister-in-
19 law and brother-in-law, Sandra and Eldred Black; his niece, Emily Clark and her
20 husband, Corey; his nephew, Lance Black; several cousins; and a host of other friends
21 and loved ones who will dearly miss his presence in their lives;
