

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Lloyd
2 Cress.

3 WHEREAS, Lloyd Cress, a native of Clay City, Kentucky, was a proud 1959
4 graduate of the University of Kentucky and a 1962 graduate of the University of
5 Kentucky College of Law; and

6 WHEREAS, after serving his country as a member of the United States Air Force,
7 Lloyd Cress worked for 55 years as an environmental attorney for the Commonwealth of
8 Kentucky; Ashland Petroleum Company; Greenebaum, Doll, and McDonald; Wyatt,
9 Tarrant, and Combs; and Dinsmore and Shohl; and

10 WHEREAS, Lloyd Cress served as the Commissioner of the Kentucky Department
11 of Environmental Protection and as the Deputy Secretary of the Energy and Environment
12 Cabinet. For his service he received the Secretary's Award from the Kentucky Energy and
13 Environment Cabinet as well as many other commendations and awards; and

14 WHEREAS, Lloyd Cress, loving husband, father, and grandfather, departed this
15 earthly life on December 27, 2017, leaving his family, friends, and all those whose lives
16 he touched in solemn mourning; and

17 WHEREAS, Lloyd Cress was preceded in death by his parents, Omer and Helen
18 Cress; his brother, Don Cress; and his first wife, Joyce Cress. He is survived by his wife,
19 Karen Caldwell; his children, Babs Cress, Rusty Cress (Lavon), and Susan Browning
20 (Mark); six grandchildren; a brother; and a host of other family members, friends, and
21 loved ones who will dearly miss his presence in their lives;
