8 the Board of Trustees for Lindsey Wilson College; and

9 WHEREAS, Lewis Garrison served his community of Adair County on various city
10 and county development boards including the airport board, the ambulance board, and the
11 Chamber of Commerce; and

12 WHEREAS, Lewis Garrison was a member of the Columbia Masonic Lodge #96,
13 Louisville Scottish Rite, Kosairs, the National Utility Contractors Association, the
14 American Road and Transportation Builders, the Kentucky Association of Highway
15 Contractors, and was a founding member of the Associated Builders and Contractors; and

16 WHEREAS, Lewis Garrison belonged to several antique tractor clubs and earned
17 numerous awards for his skills in restoring these antique vehicles; and
