3 WHEREAS, Garland Hayes was born in the Ebenezer Community of Green
4 County, Kentucky, on March 18, 1931, to the late Robert T. and Lena Wilkerson Hayes;
5 and

6 WHEREAS, Garland Hayes was a United States Army Korean War Veteran and a
7 lifelong farmer in Greensburg. He was the devoted and loving husband of Allene Sharpe
8 Hayes, who preceded him in passing on August 10, 2004; and

9 WHEREAS, Garland Hayes made a childhood profession of faith in Christ and
10 attended the Light House Baptist Church; and

11 WHEREAS, Garland Hayes departed this earthly life and entered into the kingdom
12 of Heaven on October 18, 2017, leaving his family and friends in solemn mourning; and

13 WHEREAS, in addition to his parents and wife, Garland Hayes was preceded in
14 passing by his brother, Floyd Sherman Hayes. He is survived by his son, Terry Hayes and
15 his wife, Kim; his granddaughter, Leah Hayes; and two step-grandsons, Matthew
16 Schmuck and Chance Cox; and

17 WHEREAS, Garland Hayes has had a profound and lasting impact on the
18 Greensburg community and on his loving family and a host of caring friends;
