

Amend printed copy of SB 150/GA

On page 1, delete lines 5 to 10 in their entirety and insert the following:

- "(1) Persons age twenty-one (21) or older, and otherwise able to lawfully possess a firearm, may carry concealed firearms or other concealed deadly weapons without a license in the same locations as persons with valid licenses issued under KRS 237.110 if the person:
  - (a) Demonstrates competence with a firearm by successfully completing a firearms safety or training course that meets the training requirements for licensees under KRS 237.110, and receives documentation of the completed course from the trainer leading the course; and
  - (b) Presents documentation of having completed the requirements of paragraph (a) of this subsection to the circuit clerk of his or her county of residence in order that the person's state-issued identity document, as defined in KRS 186.010, reflects eligibility to carry concealed weapons under this section.
- (2) (a) For each student seeking instruction under subsection (1)(a) of this section, the instructor trainer or certified firearms instructor leading the course shall remit twenty-five dollars (\$25) per student to the office of the sheriff of the county in which the student resides.
  - (b) The circuit clerk may impose a fee under subsection (1)(b) of this section which shall not to exceed sixty dollars (\$60). Thirty dollars (\$30) of the fee shall be

transmitted to the office of the sheriff of the county in which the person resides.

(3) Nothing in this section shall be construed to allow the carrying or possession of any deadly weapon where it is prohibited by federal law.".
