

1 AN ACT proposing an amendment to Section 32 of the Constitution of Kentucky
2 relating to the qualifications of members of the General Assembly.

3 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

4 ➔Section 1. It is proposed that Section 32 of the Constitution of Kentucky be
5 amended to read as follows:

6 No person shall be a Representative who, at the time of his or her election, is not a
7 citizen of Kentucky, has not attained the age of ~~eighteen~~^{twenty-four} years, and who has
8 not resided in this State two years next preceding his or her election, and the last year
9 thereof in the county, town or city for which he or she may be chosen. No person shall be
10 a Senator who, at the time of his or her election, is not a citizen of Kentucky, has not
11 attained the age of ~~twenty-one~~^{thirty} years, and has not resided in this State six years
12 next preceding his or her election, and the last year thereof in the district for which he or
13 she may be chosen.

14 ➔Section 2. This amendment shall be submitted to the voters of the
15 Commonwealth for their ratification or rejection at the time and in the manner provided
16 for under Sections 256 and 257 of the Constitution and under KRS 118.415. The question
17 to be presented to the voters shall read as follows: "Are you in favor of changing the
18 minimum age requirement for a member of the Kentucky House of Representatives to 18
19 and for a member of the Kentucky Senate to 21?".
