1	AN ACT relating to nurses employed by the Kentucky Department of Veterans
2	Affairs.
3	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
4	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 40 IS CREATED TO
5	READ AS FOLLOWS:
6	(1) The Kentucky Department of Veterans Affairs shall create a loan repayment
7	program for registered nurses and licensed practical nurses within their employ.
8	(2) The loan repayment program shall apply to any existing student loan incurred by
9	the employee as a result of that employee's academic or technical studies leading
10	to becoming a registered nurse or licensed practical nurse.
11	(3) The loan repayment program shall not apply to loans previously repaid.
12	(4) Recipients of the loan repayment program shall sign a contract stipulating:
13	(a) The recipient's existing student loan debt shall be repaid in the amount of
14	twenty-five percent (25%) of the loan's principle and interest up to a
15	maximum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) after satisfactory completion of
16	one (1) year of employment at the state veterans' nursing home assigned;
17	(b) The recipient's student loan shall be repaid in the amount of twenty-five
18	percent (25%) of the loan's principle and interest up to a maximum of ten
19	thousand dollars (\$10,000) after satisfactory completion of a second
20	consecutive full year of employment at the state veterans' nursing home
21	assigned; and
22	(c) A recipient may qualify for up to four (4) years of loan repayment at the
23	same rate and maximum if the recipient's employment is for consecutive
24	<u>years.</u>
25	(5) The Kentucky Higher Education Assistance Authority shall administer this
26	program from funds provided by the Kentucky Department of Veterans Affairs
27	appropriated by the General Assembly.

2		Department of Veterans Affairs shall promulgate administrative regulations
3		necessary for the effectuation of this Section including limits on the amount of
