1	AN ACT relating to apprenticeships.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 343 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in this section, unless the context requires otherwise:
6	(a) "Apprenticeship" means a program that meets the federal guidelines
7	established in 29 C.F.R. pt. 29 and 29 U.S.C. sec. 50;
8	(b) "Licensing" means any required training, education, or fee to work in a
9	specific profession; and
10	(c) "Licensing authority" means an agency, examining board, credentialing
11	board, or other office with the authority to impose occupational fees or
12	licensing requirements for any profession.
13	(2) A licensing authority shall grant a license to any applicant who:
14	(a) Completes an apprenticeship approved by the Department of Workplace
15	Standards in the Labor Department or otherwise permitted under state or
16	federal law; and
17	(b) Passes an examination, if deemed necessary by the licensing authority.
18	The apprenticeship required in paragraph (a) of this subsection may be
19	completed under a state-licensed practitioner of the occupation or at a state-
20	licensed school.
21	(3) (a) A licensing authority shall establish a passing score for its examinations,
22	which shall not exceed the passing score that is required under its standard
23	licensing processes.
24	(b) If the relevant licensing authority or statute does not require an
25	examination for the standard licensing process for an occupation, an
26	examination shall not be required for an applicant who completes an
27	apprenticeship in that occupation.

- 1 (4) When it does not conflict with federal law, apprenticeships for an occupation
- 2 <u>shall not be required to exceed the number of hours required by the relevant</u>
- 3 *licensing authority or statute for that occupation.*
- 4 (5) The relevant licensing authority shall promulgate administrative regulations
 5 <u>necessary to implement this section.</u>
- 6 (6) This section shall not apply to occupations that require professional degrees.
