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1	AN ACT relating to homestead food operators and homestead food products.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→ SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 217C IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	As used in Sections 1 and 2 of this Act:
6	(1) "Homestead food operator" means a person who produces homestead food
7	products, excluding potentially hazardous food, only in the home kitchen of that
8	person's primary residence and only for sale directly to consumers within this
9	state from the homestead residence, whether by pickup or delivery, from the
10	owner's farm stand, at farmers' markets, community events, or online, and who
11	has less than a maximum annual gross sales of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) of
12	food;
13	(2) "Potentially hazardous food" means a food requiring temperature control for
14	safety because the food is capable of supporting the rapid growth of pathogenic
15	or toxigenic microorganisms, and the growth of toxin production of clostridium
16	botulinum. Potentially hazardous food includes processed acidified and low-acid
17	canned food; and
18	(3) "Homestead food product" means all food produced by a homestead food
19	operator except potentially hazardous food.
20	→SECTION 2. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 217C IS CREATED TO
21	READ AS FOLLOWS:
22	(1) A homestead food operator who daily produces for sale less than twenty (20)
23	gallons of raw or pasteurized milk or processes less than twenty (20) gallons of
24	milk into cheese aged at least sixty (60) days, yogurt, cream, butter, or kefir shall
25	not require a permit from the Cabinet for Health and Family Services, provided
26	the products are sold as direct sales to food consumers within this state from the
27	homestead residence, whether by pickup or delivery, from the owner's farm stand,

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1	at farmers' markets, community events, or online.
2	(2) Any homestead food product containing raw or pasteurized milk from the
3	homestead residence, farm stand, at farmers' markets, community events, or
4	online shall be clearly labeled. If the product is sold in containers provided by
5	the homestead food operator, the individual container shall display a label which
6	contains the:
7	(a) Name of the homestead food operator;
8	(b) Address of the homestead food operator;
9	(c) Phone number of the homestead food operator;
10	(d) Name of the product; and
11	(e) Following statement: "This product is made with raw or pasteurized milk
12	and is exempt from Kentucky licensing and inspection."
13	→ Section 3. The following KRS section is repealed:
14	217C.090 Sale of unpasteurized goat milk.
