

1 AN ACT relating to licensed occupations.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔Section 1. KRS 322.030 is amended to read as follows:

4 KRS 322.020 shall not apply to:

- 5 (1) The work of an employee or subordinate of:
- 6 (a) A professional engineer if the work is done under the direct supervision of and  
7 verified by the professional engineer; or
- 8 (b) A professional land surveyor if the work is done under the direct supervision  
9 of and verified by the professional land surveyor;
- 10 (2) The practice of engineering or land surveying by officers and employees of the  
11 United States government while engaged in engineering or land surveying for the  
12 government;
- 13 (3) The practice of engineering or land surveying by a person on property he or she  
14 leases or owns unless:
- 15 (a) The practice involves the public safety, health, or welfare; or
- 16 (b) The land surveying relates to the location or determination of any existing or  
17 proposed land boundaries;
- 18 (4) An engineer or land surveyor engaged solely as an officer or employee of a privately  
19 owned public utility or of a business entity engaged in interstate commerce as  
20 defined in the Interstate Commerce Act (24 Stat. 379) as amended;
- 21 (5) A licensed architect who engages in the practice of engineering ~~incidental~~<sup>[incident]</sup>  
22 to the practice of architecture. ***For the purposes of this subsection, "incidental"***  
23 ***denotes any secondary element of a building which does not contribute to the***  
24 ***building's overall structural integrity. The board may promulgate administrative***  
25 ***regulations that define elements of a building or structure that are not considered***  
26 ***incidental to the practice of architecture***; or
- 27 (6) The practice of engineering related solely to the design or fabrication of

1           manufactured products. This exemption does not extend to site-specific engineering  
2           work for Kentucky locations.
