3	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:		
4		→ Section 1. KRS 164.380 is amended to read as follows:	
5	<u>(1)</u>	The board of regents of <i>Eastern Kentucky University</i> [each of the state universities	
6		or colleges] may operate, maintain, and serve as the fiscal agent for the	
7		Commonwealth's Educational Laboratory School[in connection with the college],	
8		a model and practice school under the supervision of thoroughly trained <u>and</u>	
9		certified education professionals [teachers] for the purpose of piloting and testing	
10		kindergarten through high school educational pedagogies, practices, programs,	
11		assessments, and innovations to further the educational mission of the	
12		Commonwealth[giving observation and practice work to the student teachers].	
13	<u>(2)</u>	The Commonwealth's Educational Laboratory School shall serve as a showcase	
14		for community partnerships and university collaborations of practicum and	
15		practice and as a center for professional learning and continuing education for	
16		Kentucky's teachers. Research, demonstration, and evaluation conducted at the	
17		lab school:	
18		(a) Shall respond to the needs of the education community at large;	
19		(b) May consist of pilot projects to be generated by Eastern Kentucky	
20		University, other universities, outside agencies, the Kentucky Department of	
21		Education, or the General Assembly; and	
22		(c) For projects, may be conducted by the lab school faculty, university faculty,	
23		or the Kentucky Department of Education.	
24	<u>(3)</u>	Notwithstanding any other statute to the contrary, the Commonwealth's	
25		Educational Laboratory School shall:	
26		(a) Annually receive an amount equal to the statewide guaranteed base funding	
27		level described in KRS 157.360 for each student enrolled in the lab school	

1		<u>on September 30;</u>
2	<u>(b)</u>	Annually receive a general fund appropriation equal to the state average
3		per pupil rate of ad valorem taxes described in KRS 160.460 for each
4		student enrolled in the lab school on September 30;
5	<u>(c)</u>	Annually receive the add-on funds described in KRS 157.360(2)(a) and (b)
6		for each pupil enrolled in the lab school on September 30 who meet the
7		requirements for the funding;
8	<u>(d)</u>	Annually receive the transportation add-on funds described in KRS
9		<u>157.360(2)(c) for each pupil enrolled in the lab school on September 30</u>
10		based on the average transportation per pupil add-on funds amount
11		calculated for the county school district in which the lab school is physically
12		located;
13	<u>(e)</u>	Be considered a local education agency for the purpose of receiving federal
14		funds for which the students or lab school qualifies;
15	<u>(f)</u>	Be included in on-behalf-of payments made by the state consistent with on-
16		behalf-of payments made for Kentucky school districts; and
17	<u>(g)</u>	Annually receive capital outlay funding equal to the state average per pupil
18		amount spent on capital outlay for each student enrolled in the lab school
19		on September 30.
20	<u>(4) The</u>	Kentucky Board of Education shall promulgate administrative regulations in
21	acco	ordance with KRS Chapter 13A to implement subsection (3) of this section.
