

1 AN ACT relating to pharmacists.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔Section 1. KRS 217.215 is amended to read as follows:

- 4 (1) The State Board of Pharmacy, its agents and inspectors shall have the same powers  
5 of inspection and enforcement as the cabinet under KRS 217.005 to 217.215,  
6 insofar as it relates to drugs in licensed pharmacies.
- 7 (2) The Board of Pharmacy may establish regulations relating to the storage and  
8 retrieval of prescription records in licensed pharmacies, including regulations  
9 regarding computerized recordkeeping systems.
- 10 (3) **(a)** No prescription for any drug may be refilled by a pharmacist unless authorized  
11 by the prescribing practitioner, except that ***in emergency situations in which***  
12 ***such authorization may not be readily or easily obtained from the***  
13 ***practitioner***~~[the board of pharmacy may promulgate rules and regulations to~~  
14 ~~permit] a pharmacist ***may***~~[to]:~~~~
- 15 ~~**1.(a)**~~ Dispense up to a seventy-two (72) hour supply of maintenance  
16 medication ***unless the standard unit of dispensing for the drug exceeds***  
17 ***a seventy-two (72) hour supply, in which case a pharmacist may***  
18 ***dispense a supply of maintenance medication equal to the standard***  
19 ***unit of dispensing for the drug***~~[in emergency situations in which such~~  
20 ~~authorization may not be readily or easily obtained from the~~  
21 ~~practitioner]; and~~
- 22 ~~**2.(b)**~~ Dispense up to a thirty (30) day supply of maintenance medication  
23 in emergency situations as authorized by KRS 315.500.
- 24 ~~**(b)(4)**~~ ~~[Such]~~ Emergency refills ***dispensed under this subsection*** shall not be  
25 authorized for any controlled substance or for any drug which is not essential  
26 to maintenance of life or continuation of therapy in chronic disease conditions.
- 27 **(c)** ***The Board of Pharmacy shall promulgate administrative regulations to***
