9 for 22nd place; Emily Sparks, who finished tied for 26th place; MaryKeene Marrs, who
10 finished tied for 40th place; and Delia Gibbs, who finished tied for 45th place; and

11 WHEREAS, in the team standings, Lexington Christian defeated second place
12 Sacred Heart Academy by eight strokes, and finished 33 strokes ahead of third place
13 Madison Central High School; and

14 WHEREAS, this august body congratulates the Lexington Christian Academy girls'
15 golf team upon winning the 2018 state championship, acknowledges the hard work and
16 steady leadership of Head Coach William B. Frye, and recognizes the entire Lexington
17 Christian Academy community on this day for all they have done to help these young
18 ladies become state champions;
