2	memory of James Archambeault.
3	WHEREAS, James Archambeault, the renowned Kentucky photographer who
4	captured our Commonwealth at its most beautiful, passed from this earthly life on March
5	4, 2019; and
6	WHEREAS, James Archambeault, a resident of Scott County, Kentucky, and a
7	native of Flint, Michigan, published his first book, Kentucky, in 1982. The iconic book
8	included images of Kentucky in Archambeault's stripped-down style, and many of the
9	landscapes he shot were accomplished because of his extraordinary patience, as the
10	photographer got in position and calmly waited until everything—light, angle, and
11	subject—were perfect. It was this patience and rigorous attention to detail that made
12	Archambeault a Kentucky treasure and an artist of the first order; and
13	WHEREAS, a latecomer to photography, James Archambeault graduated from
14	Duquesne University before joining the Peace Corps. He returned to Louisville at the age
15	of 26 to work for United Press International, then went on to work for the Child
16	Advocacy Council. One afternoon he was contacted by a man from Oregon who wanted
17	to turn a box of Kentucky prints into a book, and Archambeault was given the job. This
18	project led him into a career as a photographer; and
19	WHEREAS, aside from his books, James Archambeault's work has appeared in
20	publications such as Architectural Digest, National Geographic, and The Smithsonian
21	Guide to Natural America; and
22	WHEREAS, James Archambeault is survived by his beloved wife, Lee Oliphant
23	Archambeault; sister and brother-in-law, Kathy and Bennett Chamberlin; and sons, Noah
24	Oliphant and Eli Kay-Oliphant; and
25	WHEREAS, this honorable body commends those artists whose work becomes a
26	touchpoint for all Kentuckians, and whose craft is accomplished at such an extraordinary
27	level that they improve the culture of arts and artists in this Commonwealth; and
