1	A RESOLUTION encouraging the Kentucky High School Athletic Association to
2	reconsider its recent decision to reduce the number of golfers from five to four who are
3	allowed to play in the state tournament.
4	WHEREAS, competing for a high school state championship is the pinnacle of
5	competition for any young athlete in this Commonwealth; and
6	WHEREAS, on February 19, 2019, the Kentucky High School Athletic Association
7	(KHSAA) made the decision to reduce the number of competitors a team can bring to the
8	golf state tournament from five to four; and
9	WHEREAS, while the reasoning given for this drastic change was, per KHSAA
10	commissioner Julian Tackett, an attempt to address "longstanding concerns over the pace
11	of play," it is the belief of this body that the rule should be rescinded; and
12	WHEREAS, there are countless examples where this rule would be detrimental, one
13	being the 2019 state championship recently won by the Lexington Christian Academy
14	girls' golf team, which used the strength of all five of its players to carry it to a title; and
15	WHEREAS, allowing only four golfers to compete would be devastating to teams
16	who have five capable, championship-caliber golfers, and would harm the reputation of a
17	sport that has seen increased interest over the past decade; and
18	WHEREAS, four-time PGA Tour winner Steve Flesch noted that the KHSAA's
19	decision was "not growing the game or encouraging youth" and that it was "tone deaf";
20	and
21	WHEREAS, this body encourages the KHSAA to think of the young golfers who
22	would be left out of the once-in-a-lifetime achievement that is participating in a state
23	tournament, and urges the KHSAA to rethink this deeply flawed decision;
24	NOW, THEREFORE,
25	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the
26	Commonwealth of Kentucky:
27	→ Section 1. The members of the House of Representatives hereby encourage the
