

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the House of Representatives in honor and loving  
2 memory of Richard J. "Dick" Weaver.

3 WHEREAS, Richard J. "Dick" Weaver was born in York, Pennsylvania on August  
4 27, 1946, to the late Richard Eugene Weaver and Betty Elaine Barley Weaver; and

5 WHEREAS, Richard Weaver retired after 47 years spent educating the youth of  
6 Kentucky and Pennsylvania. He taught in Miami and York in Pennsylvania before  
7 moving to Kentucky and teaching in Christian County, Todd County, and Muhlenberg  
8 County. He spent his last years at University Heights Academy as music teacher and  
9 athletic director; and

10 WHEREAS, Richard Weaver shared his life as a member of First United Methodist  
11 Church; and

12 WHEREAS, Richard Weaver departed this earthly life on March 3, 2019, leaving  
13 his family, his friends, and his community in solemn mourning; and

14 WHEREAS, Richard Weaver is survived by his wife, Dianne Weaver; and his son,  
15 Justin J. Weaver;
