3 WHEREAS, women have formally served in the United States Armed Forces 4 starting with the Army Nurse Corps in 1901, but they have informally served since the 5 inception of the military; and

6 WHEREAS, the women veteran population is one of the fastest growing segments
7 among United States veterans, with 18.2 million living veterans and approximately 2
8 million of whom are women; and

9 WHEREAS, women veterans have served with dedication, honor, and bravery; and

10 WHEREAS, women veterans have served on the battlefield and the frontlines and 11 continue to serve by actively engaging in efforts to improve their communities and 12 promote a strong America; and

WHEREAS, women veterans have made an invaluable impact both locally andthroughout the world; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the observance of Women's History Month, the Commonwealth salutes women veterans who in peacetime or times of peril and in a variety of demanding roles have demonstrated skill, sacrifice, and a devotion to freedom;

18 NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the
Commonwealth of Kentucky:

Section 1. The members of the House of Representatives urge all citizens at all
times to recognize the service and sacrifice of women veterans in defense of this
Commonwealth and Nation, and to specifically honor women veterans during the first
weekend of March, to be known as Women Veterans Weekend.
