| 6  | 2 diabetes, ear and respiratory infections, and sudden infant death syndrome (SIDS); and    |
| 7  | WHEREAS, according to the CDC, breastfeeding can help lower a mother's risk of:             |
| 8  | high blood pressure, Type 2 diabetes, ovarian cancer, and breast cancer; and                |
| 9  | WHEREAS, according to the CDC, low rates of breastfeeding add more than \$3                 |
| 10 | billion a year to medical costs for mothers and children in the United States; and          |
| 11 | WHEREAS, Kentucky ranked 46th among all states in the percentage of infants                 |
| 12 | born in 2015 who were ever breastfed, 73.9%; and  |
| 13 | WHEREAS, the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) requires employers with more                   |
| 14 | than 50 employees to provide reasonable break time for an employee to express breast        |
| 15 | milk for her nursing child for one year after the child's birth each time such employee has |
| 16 | need to express milk and to provide a place, other than a bathroom, for the employee to     |
| 17 | express breast milk; and  |
| 18 | WHEREAS, KRS 211.755 states that a woman has the right to breastfeed her child              |
| 19 | wherever she herself is allowed to be; and  |
| 20 | WHEREAS, there is not currently a designated safe, appropriate place in the                 |
| 21 | Capitol Annex for mothers who are employees or who are members of the visiting public       |
| 22 | to breastfeed and express milk;   |
| 23 | NOW, THEREFORE,   |
| 24 | Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the               |
