1	A RESOLUTION encouraging citizens to recognize the achievements of
2	audiologists and speech-language pathologists.
3	WHEREAS, communication disorders are among the most common conditions in
4	adults and children, costing the United States billions annually due to lost work
5	productivity, special education, and medical treatment; and
6	WHEREAS, those citizens of the Commonwealth of Kentucky who have overcome
7	their communication disorders through the services of dedicated audiologists and speech-
8	language pathologists should be recognized; and
9	WHEREAS, this body and the citizens of the Commonwealth of Kentucky also
10	recognize and value the efforts of all audiologists and speech-language pathologists who
11	work to help these individuals with communication disorders lead independent,
12	productive, and fulfilling lives; and
13	WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Kentucky is proud and honored to have 3037
14	licensed speech-language pathologists and 253 licensed audiologists offering quality
15	education and healthcare services to its citizens;
16	NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the
Commonwealth of Kentucky:

Section 1. The members of the House of Representatives encourage all citizens
to recognize the achievements of audiologists and speech-language pathologists in
improving the quality of life for people with communication disorders.
