

1 AN ACT proposing an amendment to Section 54 of the Constitution of Kentucky.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔Section 1. It is proposed that Section 54 of the Constitution of Kentucky be
4 amended to read as follows:

5 The General Assembly shall have~~[-no]~~ power to:

6 ***(1) Limit the amount to be recovered in noneconomic damages for injuries***
7 ***resulting in death;~~[-]~~***

8 ***(2) Limit the amount to be recovered in noneconomic damages~~[-or]~~ for injuries***
9 ***to person or property; and***

10 ***(3) Provide for a uniform statute of limitations or statutes of repose, or both,***
11 ***for any civil action for injuries resulting in death or for injuries to persons or property.***

12 ➔Section 2. This amendment shall be submitted to the voters of the
13 Commonwealth for their ratification or rejection at the time and in the manner provided
14 for under Sections 256 and 257 of the Constitution and under KRS 118.415. The question
15 to be presented to the voters shall read as follows: "Are you in favor of permitting the
16 General Assembly to: (1) Place limits on the amount to be recovered in noneconomic
17 damages for injuries resulting in death; (2) Place limits on the amount to be recovered in
18 noneconomic damages for injuries to person or property; and (3) Create statutes of
19 limitations or statutes of repose as to how long after the incident a lawsuit may be
20 commenced?".
