2	Be it	t enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3		→ SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 211 IS CREATED TO
4	REA	AD AS FOLLOWS:
5	<u>(1)</u>	The Department for Public Health shall develop a statewide education,
6		awareness, and information program on bone marrow registries in the
7		Commonwealth. The program shall include, but not be limited to, information
8		about:
9		(a) The need for bone marrow donations;
10		(b) Patient populations that would benefit from bone marrow donations;
11		(c) How to join a bone marrow registry; and
12		(d) How to acquire a free buccal swab kit from a bone marrow registry.
13	<u>(2)</u>	The Department for Public Health shall disseminate the bone marrow education,
14		awareness, and information program materials established in this section on its
15		Internet Web site, electronically, and in any other manner determined by the
16		department to promote bone marrow donation education, awareness, and
17		information that can increase the understanding of bone marrow donation
18		among the general public of the Commonwealth.
19	<u>(3)</u>	All primary health care practitioners and urgent treatment facility or urgent care
20		facility health care practitioners may inquire of new patients who are between
21		eighteen (18) years of age and forty-five (45) years of age, on new patient intake
22		forms, as to whether the patient is registered with a bone marrow registry in the
23		Commonwealth. If the patient states that he or she is not registered with a bone
24		marrow registry in the Commonwealth, the practitioner is encouraged to provide
25		the patient the information on bone marrow education, awareness, and
26		information program materials established in this section.
