

1 AN ACT relating to sexual violence training.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔Section 1. KRS 311A.120 is amended to read as follows:

- 4 (1) As a condition of being issued a certificate or license as an emergency medical
5 technician or first responder, the applicant shall have completed a Kentucky Board
6 of Emergency Medical Services approved educational course on the transmission,
7 control, treatment, and prevention of the human immunodeficiency virus and
8 acquired immunodeficiency syndrome with an emphasis on appropriate behavior
9 and attitude change.
- 10 (2) The board shall ***promulgate administrative regulations to*** require continuing
11 education for emergency medical technicians or first responders that includes the
12 completion of one ***(1) hour***~~[and one-half (1.5) hours]~~ of board approved continuing
13 education covering the recognition and prevention of pediatric abusive head trauma,
14 as defined in KRS 620.020, at least one (1) time every ***two (2) year renewal***
15 ***cycle***~~[five (5) years]~~. The one ***(1) hour***~~[and one-half (1.5) hours]~~ required under this
16 section shall be included in the current number of required continuing education
17 hours.
- 18 ***(3) The board shall promulgate administrative regulations to require continuing***
19 ***education for emergency medical technicians or first responders which includes***
20 ***the completion of a training course of at least one (1) hour covering awareness of***
21 ***sexual violence, including reporting options, care options, pre-hospital treatment***
22 ***considerations, knowledge of regional rape crisis centers, and how to access the***
23 ***SANE-ready list, at least one (1) time every two (2) year renewal cycle. The one***
24 ***(1) hour of continuing education required under this subsection shall be included***
25 ***in the current number of required continuing education hours.***
