

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION designating the Constable J.B. Marcum Memorial
2 Highway in Madison County.

3 WHEREAS, John Bryant "J. B." Marcum Sr. worked for the Madison County
4 Board of Education for 22 years, primarily working at Madison Southern High School
5 and Foley Middle School; and

6 WHEREAS, J. B. Marcum served the citizens of Berea and Madison County for 42
7 years as the District 1 Constable, the longest-serving elected public official in the
8 Commonwealth; and

9 WHEREAS, J. B. Marcum was a dedicated member of Bethel Baptist Church,
10 located in Berea; and

11 WHEREAS, J. B. Marcum was also a Kentucky Colonel, and a member of the
12 Kentucky Constables Association; and

13 WHEREAS, J. B. Marcum was an honorable, selfless, and caring individual who
14 dedicated a large portion of his life to serving the citizens of Madison County; and

15 WHEREAS, J. B. Marcum traversed these earthly bond on December 21, 2016,
16 after a long-fought battle with non-Hodgkin's lymphoma;

17 NOW, THEREFORE,

18 ***Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

19 ➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 956 in
20 Madison County, from the intersection with Interstate 75 to the intersection with United
21 States Route 25, as the "Constable J.B. Marcum Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30
22 days of the effective date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signs denoting this
23 designation.
