1	A JOINT RESOLUTION relating to child abuse and neglect awareness.
2	WHEREAS, the 2016 Child Maltreat Report published by the United States
3	Department of Health and Human Services reports that 19 out of every 1,000 Kentucky
4	children have been victimized by child abuse or neglect; and
5	WHEREAS, according to the 2016 Child Maltreat Report, Kentucky is burdened
6	with the second highest rate of child abuse and neglect in the nation; and
7	WHEREAS, the General Assembly aspires to protect Kentucky's children by
8	eradicating child abuse and neglect across the Commonwealth; and
9	WHEREAS, educating Kentucky's children about the signs of child abuse and
10	neglect empowers children to recognize instances of abuse and neglect; and
11	WHEREAS, educating Kentucky's students about how to report child abuse and
12	neglect shows the silent victims of abuse and neglect that they have a trusted person to
13	talk to in our schools;
14	NOW, THEREFORE,
15	Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
16	→ Section 1. Schools across Kentucky are strongly encouraged to recognize April
17	6 of each year as Child Abuse Prevention Day in the Commonwealth. On this day,
18	Kentucky schools are encouraged to educate their students about the signs of child abuse
19	and neglect and how to report child abuse or neglect to a trusted adult.
20	→ Section 2. The Kentucky Department of Education shall develop age-
