

1 A RESOLUTION honoring Angie Beavin upon being named a recipient of the
2 2018-2019 Milken Educator Award.

3 WHEREAS, Ms. Angie Beavin, a National Board Certified educator, is an 11 year
4 veteran teacher of third and fifth grade students at Peaks Mills Elementary in Franklin
5 County; and

6 WHEREAS, in addition to her duties as an educator, Ms. Beavin leads professional
7 development at Peaks Mill, mentors fellow teachers, provides resources and instructional
8 strategies, and is known as Peak Mill's go-to educator for instructional practices; and

9 WHEREAS, Ms. Beavin has played a significant role in Peaks Mill improving from
10 the lowest-performing elementary school in the school district to the highest, with her
11 students achieving the best math and reading growth in the district; and

12 WHEREAS, on February 11, 2019, Ms. Beavin was awarded the Milken Educator
13 Award, hailed as the "Oscars of teaching", which rewards excellence in education by
14 honoring top educators around the country in early to mid-career for what they have
15 achieved and for the promise of what they will accomplish; and

16 WHEREAS, this prestigious national award comes with public recognition and an
17 unrestricted \$25,000 cash prize; and

18 WHEREAS, Ms. Beavin is the only Milken Educator Award winner from Kentucky
19 this year and one of only 33 honorees nationally;
