

1 A RESOLUTION honoring The Healing Place.

2 WHEREAS, The Healing Place has served Metro Louisville and surrounding areas  
3 since 1989 with a nationally recognized, innovative social model recovery program for  
4 drug and alcohol addiction with a success rate of 75 percent; and

5 WHEREAS, more than 5,000 men and women are living sober, productive lives  
6 because of The Healing Place's unique approach to recovery; and

7 WHEREAS, The Healing Place's model relies on the assistance and guidance of its  
8 alumni to supplement traditional approaches to recovery; and

9 WHEREAS, this model has been replicated in 14 facilities across the  
10 Commonwealth as well as in facilities located in Richmond, Virginia, and Raleigh, North  
11 Carolina; and

12 WHEREAS, after four years of hard work and two years of construction, expansion  
13 of The Healing Place's Men's Campus at 10th and Market Streets in Louisville was just  
14 completed, and clients moved into the building at the beginning of 2019; and

15 WHEREAS, the new building has capacity for 426 men. There are now 50 beds in  
16 the detox unit as well as 60 beds available for homeless veterans who are seeking help for  
17 substance abuse issues; and

18 WHEREAS, this body rightfully honors everyone involved with The Healing Place  
19 on this day, and duly grants all its administrators, staff, alumni, and current clients best  
20 wishes as they fight the addiction crisis in this Commonwealth;

21 NOW, THEREFORE,

22 ***Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of***  
23 ***Kentucky:***

24 ➔Section 1. The members of the Senate hereby honor The Healing Place and  
25 commend the facility for its three decades of service to the Louisville Metro community.
