3 WHEREAS, William "Bill" Edgar Graves was born to the late Edgar Surface and  
4 Grace Rebecca Bullock Graves on May 8, 1921; and

5 WHEREAS, Bill Graves was deeply involved in the life of his family and  
6 community, where he was a beloved mentor and educator for many students during his  
7 years of service in the Boone County School District; and

8 WHEREAS, Bill Graves served as a past director of the Boone County Farm  
9 Bureau and a member emeritus of the Boone County Fair Board; and

10 WHEREAS, Bill Graves was the oldest member of the Hebron Lutheran Church,  
11 member of the Hebron Lions Club, eldest member of the Sons of the American  
12 Revolution, and member of the Hebron Masonic Lodge 757 for over 50 years; and

13 WHEREAS, Bill Graves was preceded in death by his wife, Virginia Lee Graves,  
14 and his brothers, Robert Linton and James Graves. He is survived by his loving children,  
15 Virginia Sue Graves Spalding, Sally Ann Burcham, and Randy Graves; ten grandchildren;
