9	substitute Sunday school teacher; and
10	WHEREAS, Cathy Goble Gullett was a graduate of Prestonsburg Community
11	College, where she is a distinguished alumna, the University of Kentucky, and Morehead
12	State University; and
13	WHEREAS, Cathy Goble Gullett was a longtime educator, retiring from Johnson
14	Central High School in 2004. While at Johnson Central she took on several duties,
15	including teaching English and journalism, editing the school newspaper, assisting the
16	swim team, girls' and boys' basketball teams, and coaching the cheerleading and girls' golf

18	WHEREAS, Cathy Goble Gullett led her teams at JCHS to several runner-up and
19	regional golf championships, and saw one of her golfers win an individual state
20	championship. A member of the KHSAA Golf Board, she worked at summer golf camps
21	and at the Paintsville Golf Course, and assisted the Morehead State University Dr. Rex
22	Chaney Golf Academy for more than two decades; and
23	WHEREAS, Cathy Goble Gullett was instrumental in fundraising to help provide
24	golf scholarships for area youth; and
25	WHEREAS, Cathy Goble Gullett was a longtime supporter of 4-H, serving on the
26	local council and attending state conferences throughout her life; and
27	WHEREAS, Cathy Goble Gullett was inducted into Johnson Central High School's
