2 WHEREAS, Gerard Gerhard is a retired attorney and Assistant Attorney General;

WHEREAS, for many years, Gerard Gerhard has been an outspoken advocate for safer roads in Kentucky and across this nation, researching and challenging city, state, and federal transportation engineers and officials to act on signage in order to save lives as well as curtail damage to property in accidents; and

8 WHEREAS, working on his own time, Gerard Gerhard has analyzed records for 9 single-car fatal accidents since 2002 and utilized that information to make 10 recommendations to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, leading to the posting of many 11 signs and warnings marking for motorists the approach of dangerous curves; and

12 WHEREAS, Gerard Gerhard was also responsible for the centralization of state13 automobile registrations; and

WHEREAS, this honorable body rightfully recognizes the good work of Gerard Gerhard on this day, and duly thanks him for his years of service to the greater good service that is largely accomplished without any fanfare or credit given to him; and

WHEREAS, this body further commends Gerard Gerhard for the sacrifices he has
made to make Kentucky's roads safer, and grants him very best wishes as he continues to
be an advocate for safer roadways;
