

1 A RESOLUTION honoring the Trinity High School basketball team upon winning  
2 the KHSAA State Championship.

3 WHEREAS, on March 10, 2019, at historic Rupp Arena in Lexington, Kentucky,  
4 the Trinity Shamrocks defeated Scott County High School to win the Whitaker  
5 Bank/KHSAA Boys' Sweet Sixteen Basketball Tournament; and

6 WHEREAS, the state title was the second in the illustrious history of the Trinity  
7 program, and its first since 2012; and

8 WHEREAS, Trinity's staunch defense held Scott County to just 40 points, and a 21-  
9 point fourth-quarter surge led the Rocks to the title; and

10 WHEREAS, Trinity was paced by Sweet Sixteen Most Valuable Player and  
11 University of Louisville signee David Johnson, who scored a game-high 22 points,  
12 grabbed 12 rebounds, and tallied four blocks. Stan Turnier finished with 17 points and  
13 seven rebounds, while Jamil Hardaway scored eight; and

14 WHEREAS, Trinity capped an incredible 2018-2019 campaign, winning 30 games  
15 against only 8 losses, avenging a heartbreaking 54-53 loss to the Cardinals in the first  
16 round of the 2018 Sweet Sixteen; and

17 WHEREAS, this honorable body rightfully congratulates the Trinity High School  
18 basketball team on this day upon winning the Sweet Sixteen title, acknowledges the hard  
19 work and many sacrifices made by Head Coach Mike Szabo and his coaching staff, and  
20 commends the entire Trinity community for all they have done—on and off the basketball  
21 court—to help these young men become champions;
