- 18 Cabinet to establish an Office of Intermodal and Freight Rail Advocacy.
- 19 → Section 2. The primary duties of this office should be to provide policy
- 20 recommendations on improving and maintaining modes of commercial transportation that
- best reflect the needs of business and the general public.
