

1           A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Margery  
2 Evans Arnold.

3           WHEREAS, Margery Evans Arnold was born in 1921 in Charleston, South  
4 Carolina to the late E. Earl and Maude Glasgow Evans; and

5           WHEREAS, after moving to Knoxville, Tennessee, Margery Arnold graduated  
6 from Knoxville Central High School in 1938. She continued her education by briefly  
7 attending Western College in Oxford, Ohio before transferring to the University of  
8 Tennessee to graduate in 1942; and

9           WHEREAS, Margery Arnold interned at Massachusetts General Hospital before  
10 moving to Kingston, Tennessee to work as a registered dietician at Tennessee Eastman  
11 cafeteria; and

12           WHEREAS, while working at Eastman, Margery Arnold met her husband, Walter  
13 Klinton Arnold, and they joined their lives together in 1945. She shared her life with him  
14 until his death in 2001; and

15           WHEREAS, Margery Arnold served her community as an active member of St.  
16 Paul's Episcopal parish for many years and was a founding member of St. Timothy's  
17 parish. She was active in Altar Guild and the youth groups for both churches; and

18           WHEREAS, Margery Arnold volunteered at Holston Valley Community Hospital,  
19 teaching prenatal care classes. She also used her knowledge to serve area nursing homes  
20 as a consulting dietician; and

21           WHEREAS, planning and traveling with her husband Walter extensively through  
22 Europe and North America were a delight to her; and

23           WHEREAS, Margery Arnold departed this earthly life on February 23, 2019  
24 leaving her family, her friends, and her community in solemn mourning; and

25           WHEREAS, Margery Arnold is preceded in death by her husband, Walter Klinton  
26 Arnold. She is survived by her two sons, Dr. David Arnold and his wife Rose, and Dr.  
27 Graham Arnold; five grandchildren, Dr. Ellen Fenzel Arnold, Klinton Evans Arnold and

1 wife Kelley, James Skidmore Arnold and wife Erin, Dr. Edith Arnold Sullivan and  
2 husband Alec, and James Franklin Arnold and wife Michelle; four great grandchildren,  
3 Annie, Clyde, Aubrey, and Mason;
