

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Martha
2 McClain.

3 WHEREAS, Martha McClain was born on November 30, 1945, the daughter of the
4 late Francis and Joseph Houk; and

5 WHEREAS, Martha McClain graduated from West High School in Columbus,
6 Ohio before attending Campbellsville College; and

7 WHEREAS, Martha McClain was a secretary at the University of Alabama before
8 becoming a self-employed court reporter in Frankfort. She then worked as a legal
9 secretary for the Cabinet for Health and Family Services, the Labor Cabinet, Kentucky
10 Higher Education Assistance Authority, and the Kentucky Public Service Commission;

12 WHEREAS, Martha McClain ran a personal business called "Let's Face It",
13 focusing on face painting. She took great joy in seeing a child's face light up because of
14 her work; and

15 WHEREAS, Martha McClain served as secretary and director of veteran's outreach
16 for Kratom United and worked with Veterans Care Alliance Botanicals, both of which are
17 organizations which advocate for herbal alternatives for pain management; and

18 WHEREAS, Martha McClain, beloved mother, grandmother, sister, and great-
19 grandmother, departed this earthly life on December 20th, 2018, leaving those who knew
20 and loved her in solemn mourning; and

21 WHEREAS, Martha McClain is preceded in death by her parents. She is survived
22 by her two daughters, Alexandra Seyberth and Kelly Devine; two sisters, June Kelly and
23 Margi McGuire; four grandchildren, Courtney May, Ben Seyberth, Bonnie Seyberth, and
24 Charlie Seyberth; and five great-grandchildren, Landon May, Audrina Seyberth, Bentley
25 Seyberth, Addison West, and Arabella Seyberth;
