3	WHEREAS, Thomas Wayne White was born in 1933 in Plymouth, Indiana; and
4	WHEREAS, Thomas White graduated from the University of Kentucky with a
5	degree in journalism after serving as sports editor for the Kentucky Kernel his senior
6	year; and
7	WHEREAS, Thomas White started as a sports writer for a small paper in Somerset,
8	Kentucky, before joining the Lexington Leader as Deputy Sports Editor in 1961; and
9	WHEREAS, Thomas White covered Transylvania University basketball, University
10	of Kentucky football and basketball, and harness racing. He also wrote the high school
11	sports column, "The White Line"; and
12	WHEREAS, Thomas White fell in love with harness racing and left the Leader to
13	become a writer and reporter for the Horseman and Fair World and Hoofbeats magazines;
14	and
15	WHEREAS, in 1973, Thomas White became director of publicity and public
16	relations at The Red Mile and Tattersails horse sales, a position he held for 15 years,
17	before leaving there to direct publicity and public relations at Scioto Downs Racetrack in
18	Columbus, Ohio; and
19	WHEREAS, Thomas White mentored many college students through internships
20	that he established at the University of Kentucky and Eastern Kentucky University,
21	guided many young racing harness colleagues, and taught a course in sports writing at
22	Eastern Kentucky University's School of Journalism; and
23	WHEREAS, in 2008, Thomas White was recognized by his peers by being inducted
24	into the Harness Racing Hall of Fame located in Goshen, New York; and
25	WHEREAS, Thomas White shared his faith life as a member of Maxwell Street
26	Presbyterian Church and served as an elder. He was also active in Men of Maxwell,
27	taught a Men's Sunday School class, and spent many years greeting members and visitors
