

1 A RESOLUTION adopting the Rules of Procedure for the 2019 Extraordinary
2 Session of the House of Representatives.

3 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the*
4 *Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

5 ➔Section 1. Except as provided in Section 2 of this Resolution, the Rules of
6 Procedure governing the House of Representatives immediately prior to sine die
7 adjournment of the 2019 Regular Session of the House of Representatives are adopted as
8 the Rules of Procedure governing the House of Representatives for the 2019
9 Extraordinary Session.

10 ➔Section 2. House Rule 49 is amended to read as follows:

11 **Rule 49. Procedure in Committee.** The rules of procedure in the House shall be
12 observed in committee insofar as the same are applicable. The committee chair, or the
13 committee by majority vote in a regularly called meeting during a regular session of the
14 General Assembly, shall post at least three calendar days prior to their consideration the
15 bills and resolutions to be considered by the committee at its next meeting, provided that
16 no bill or resolution shall be posted by the chair or the committee by a majority vote
17 unless and until a request for posting form has been filed with the committee chair or
18 secretary and approved by the committee chair as containing satisfactory information. No
19 measure shall be considered except those posted, unless the measure is one which has
20 been recommitted to the same committee from which it was previously reported with a
21 favorable expression. During a regular session of the General Assembly, a list of the
22 measures to be considered shall be filed with the Clerk at least three calendar days prior
23 to the meeting. In the case of prefiled House bills receiving the affirmative votes of a
24 majority of the House members of the interim joint committee to which they were
25 assigned, posting by the chair or the committee shall occur during the first four days of
26 the session, and those bills may be considered by the appropriate committee during the
27 first fifteen legislative days of the session. No posting request shall be required for those

- 1 prefiled bills. *During an extraordinary session, the posting requirement in this rule*
- 2 *shall be modified from at least three calendar days to at least one calendar day.*
