2	Be it	t enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3		→ Section 1. KRS 518.090 is amended to read as follows:
4	(1)	A person is guilty of assault of a sports official when he <u>or she</u> intentionally causes
5		physical injury to a sports official:
6		(a) Who was performing sports official duties at the time the physical injury was
7		perpetrated; or
8		(b) If the physical injury occurs while the sports official is arriving at or departing
9		from the athletic facility at which the athletic event occurred.
10	(2)	For the purposes of this section, "sports official" means an individual who serves as
11		a referee, umpire, linesman, or in a similar capacity that may be known by another
12		title, and who is duly registered as or is a member of a national, state, regional, or
13		local organization engaged, in part, in providing education and training to sports
14		officials.
15	(3)	A person who is guilty of assault of a sports official shall[, for a first offense,] be
16		guilty of a[Class A misdemeanor, unless the defendant assembles with five (5) or
17		more persons for the purpose of assaulting a sports official, in which case it is a]
18		Class D felony.
19	(4)	A person who is guilty of assault of a sport official shall, for a second or subsequent
20		offense, be guilty of a Class D felony.]
21		→ SECTION 2. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 518 IS CREATED TO
22	REA	AD AS FOLLOWS:
23	<u>(1)</u>	A person is guilty of intimidation of a sports official when he or she, directly or
24		indirectly, makes any threat to a sports official with the intent to cause the sports
25		official to commit, make, or delay any act, decision, or determination regarding a
26		present or future sports contest, if the threat communicates present or future
27		intent to:

1	(a) Cause physical injury to any person;
2	(b) Cause physical damage to the property of any person other than the person
3	making the threat;
4	(c) Subject any person other than the person making the threat to physical
5	confinement or restraint; or
6	(d) Commit any other act which is illegal and is intended to substantially harm
7	any person other than the person making the threat with respect to the
8	person's health, safety, business, financial condition, or personal
9	<u>relationships.</u>
10	(2) Intimidation of a sports official is a Class A misdemeanor.
11	(3) As used in this section, "sports official" has the same meaning as Section 1 of
12	this Act.
13	→ Section 3. The restrictions of KRS 6.945(1) shall not apply to Section 2 of this
14	Act.
