1	A RESOLUTION declaring May 2020 to be Ehlers-Danlos Syndrome Awareness
2	Month.
3	WHEREAS, in 400 BC, the ancient Greek physician Hippocrates first described the
4	symptoms of the medical condition now known as Ehlers-Danlos syndrome, the
5	collective name for 13 genetic connective tissue disorders; and
6	WHEREAS, in 1901, Dr. Edvard Ehlers recognized the syndrome as a distinct
7	medical condition, and in 1908, Dr. Henri-Alexandre Danlos postulated that skin
8	hyperextensibility, which is skin that can be stretched farther than normal, and tissue
9	fragility were its core elements; and
10	WHEREAS, joint hypermobility, or joints that can be stretched farther than normal,
11	is also prominently associated with Ehlers-Danlos syndrome; and
12	WHEREAS, among the types of connective tissue disorders classified as Ehlers-
13	Danlos syndrome are those featuring a predominantly cardiac-valvular, dermatological, or
14	periodontal impact; and
15	WHEREAS, signs and symptoms of Ehlers-Danlos syndrome may become apparent
16	during childhood but depending upon the form and severity, age of diagnosis varies
17	widely; and
18	WHEREAS, estimates for the incidence of all Ehlers-Danlos syndrome types range
19	from 1 per 2,500 to 1 per 5,000 births though some types of Ehlers-Danlos syndrome are
20	much more rare; and
21	WHEREAS, because of its rarity, a correct diagnosis can require many years to
22	obtain, during which the individual might experience extreme physical pain; and
23	WHEREAS, Ehlers-Danlos syndrome disproportionately affects women; and
24	WHEREAS, no cure has been discovered for Ehlers-Danlos syndrome, but once
25	properly diagnosed, its symptoms can usually be managed; and
26	WHEREAS, the Commonwealth seeks to increase awareness about the existence of
27	Ehlers-Danlos syndrome, the importance of a correct and early diagnosis, and the need for

- 2 NOW, THEREFORE,
- 3 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the
- 4 Commonwealth of Kentucky:
- 5 → Section 1. This honorable body hereby declares May 2020 to be Ehlers-Danlos
 6 Syndrome Awareness Month.
